



“[Assassination of the Buddha](#) -- the Truth about the Death of His Holiness the 10th Panchen Lama” is written by Yuan Hongbing, an exiled Chinese author, poet-philosopher and jurist and Namloyak Dhungser, a bilingual (Tibetan and Chinese) poet and an independent researcher of Tibetology. The book unveils the conspiracy of the century — the assassination by the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) of His Holiness the 10th Panchen Lama. The book also reveals the crisis of the extinction of ethnic Tibetans under the CCP’s tyrannical cultural genocide policy. The book describes clearly how the 10th Panchen Lama was the spiritual leader of contemporary Tibetan Buddhist Revival, Tibetan Culture Renaissance and Tibet Revival Movements.

This book not only exposes the details of how the CCP assassinated the 10th Panchen Lama, but also describes the 10th Panchen Lama's sadness. The story is both thrilling and shocking. The CCP’s crime of assassinating the Buddha and the 10th Panchen Lama's tragedy is directly related to the fate of all Tibetans. ### Brief Intro

A meeting to determine to assassinate the Buddha was held in the sitting room of Deng Xiaoping’s home in November 1987. The participants were Deng Xiaoping, Chen Yun, Li Xiannian, Bo Yibo, and Song Ping. Wang Zhen (for health reasons), Yang Shangkun (occupied elsewhere) and Peng Zhen (occupied elsewhere) were absent from the meeting.

Soon after the meeting, the oligarchic group of the founding members of CCP identified two

people to preside over the execution of the plan for “Special Arrangement for Panchen”. They were Hu Jintao and Wen Jiabao.

Wen Jiabao was the director of the General Office of the Chinese Communist Party Central Committee and the Secretary of the Secretariat of the Chinese Communist Party Central Committee (for a vacancy) at that time. Wen Jiabao’s position stretched across the two bodies.

Song Ping, one member of the oligarchic group recommended Hu Jintao who was in the position of the Secretary of Guizhou provincial party committee to Deng Xiaoping to serve as the secretary of Tibet Autonomous Region.
